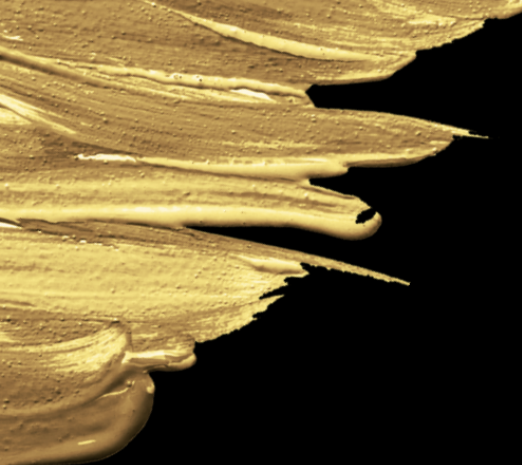
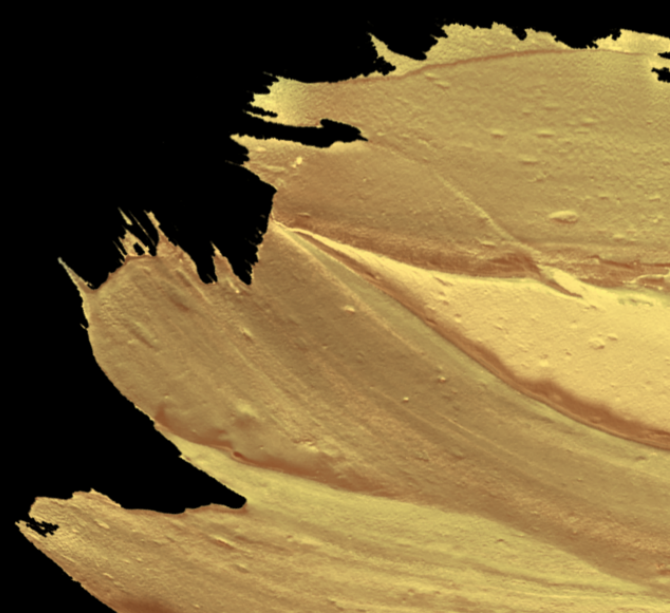

The Ones Who Are Coming

Reflection

Think about the empty seats as a representation of people who will come. The lost, the broken, the military family, the disconnected, the unfulfilled, and think about that "person". Spiritual growth does not happen by accident. God transforms us as we worship, study His Word, pray, serve, and encourage one another. Every person who will be in this room is somewhere on the journey of faith. Some are taking their first steps. Others are learning to trust God through difficult seasons.

Scripture

When he has found it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders, and coming home, he calls his friends and neighbors together, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, because I have found my lost sheep!' I tell you, in the same way, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who don't need repentance. Luke 15: 4 - 7

- People would experience God's love.
- Those who feel far from God would be drawn closer to Him and they would find hope, purpose and belonging.
- Christ's Church will be a light in our community, drawing others to Jesus.

"We will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, his power, and the wonders he has done." Psalm 78:4

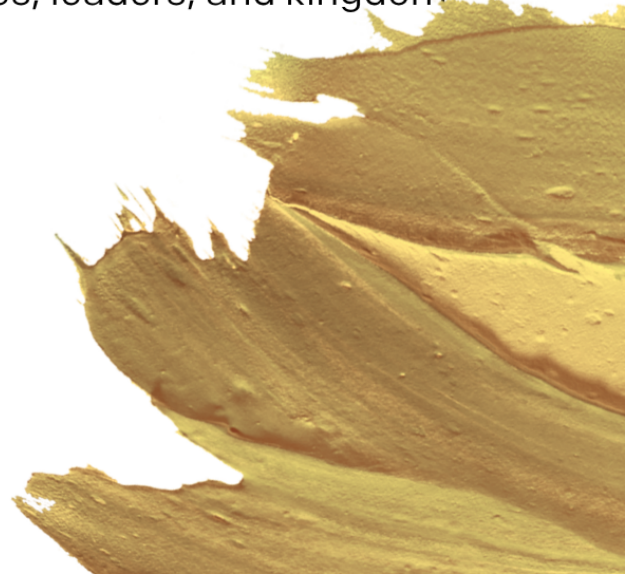
"Jesus said, 'Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these.'" Matthew 19:14

Reflection

Scripture

Pray for

- God, give me a heart for the people You have placed in my life.
- God, show me my "one" and help me love them well.
- God, use my life to bless others and point them to Jesus.
- God, send our church to impact our community and the world.
- God, help me trust You with where You place me and what You ask of me.

Action
